School Supply List – Grades 10 through 12

General – all students will require:

- Two 2" binders are usually sufficient to contain all course materials during a semester
- Each course should have one package of dividers (with at least 5 tabs in each package)
- 400 sheets loose leaf paper
- Sufficient pencils, pens (blue/black), erasers, correction tape (usually about 2 dozen pens/pencils is sufficient)
- Ruler (metric, at least 30 cm)
- Scientific calculator (not a "graphing" calculator these are supplied when required)
- Pencil case/bag
- USB memory stick (4 GB, we suggest one with a lanyard or ring so it can be secured into a binder)

Specialized Supplies – depending on courses being taken:

Mathematics

- 100 sheets graph paper (in notebook or loose)
- Protractor

French

· Verb Book, French Dictionary

Physical Education

- Running Shoes (non-marking soles), sport socks, shorts or sweat pants, T-Shirts
- Separate lock for gym lockers

Art

- Sketch Book (minimum 9" x 12"), Duotang notebook, loose leaf
- 10 HB pencils, 3B pencil, white vinyl eraser
- ruler, scissors, glue stick

Band/Music

- 1" Binder with dividers, Maintenance Kit for Instrument
- Students are responsible for renting or purchasing an Instrument
- Other courses may require additional supplies. Students in courses that require additional supplies will receive lists at the start of each course.

Note:

- All students are supplied a combination lock for their hallway locker on the first day of school
- Agendas/planners will be available in the office upon request
- If acquiring these supplies will be difficult due to financial or other factors, please contact the school's administration and we will make arrangements for supplies to be provided.
