

Capstone Project Final Assessment/Grades

Capstone projects are due Friday, January 10. We will have space in the school for them to be displayed and reviewed between 10 am and 12 noon that day (Period 3/4 double block).

Your capstone teacher (Brogdon, Sikkes, or Giczi/Sward) will be responsible for grading your capstone project on a pass/fail basis.

Here are the Capstone project criteria (each of these is yes/no, pass/fail) – all five criteria must be yes/pass for the overall project to receive a pass and the corresponding 52% towards your CLC 12 grade:

Does your project:

1. Represent the completion of your proposal?
 - a. Your project should be planned thoughtfully to increase your skills in a particular competency. We don't want projects that were thrown together at the last possible moment.
2. Connect to one or more of the Core Competencies?
 - a. The point of these projects is for you to improve in one (or more) Core Competencies. It must be made clear to us which one (or more) competencies that you are trying to address.
3. Demonstrate personal growth in one or more of the Core Competencies?
 - a. Ideally, some growth in the identified competency (or competencies) should have occurred in the execution of this project. If not, significant reflection about why growth didn't occur will need to be shown for Criteria 5 (below).
4. Demonstrate at least 30 hours of effort/work?
 - a. Much class time was allocated for work on the capstone project throughout this semester. It needs to be obvious that at least 30 hours was devoted to it. Logs, photos, and videos may help you to demonstrate this if it is not obvious.
5. Demonstrate reflection about what this project taught you about yourself?
 - a. Again, this project is mostly about helping you develop yourself. Some evidence of your reflection and thoughts about what this capstone did to help you develop personally will be required.

Overdue module assignments will not be accepted after Wednesday, January 15 at 12 noon.

Final marks for report cards will be submitted on Thursday, January 16 - capstones completed after that time may not be reflected on the report card.

Capstone projects will be accepted until the end of the school year if not passed before the end of the semester.
